Biographies of the jury

Shida Bazyar, born in 1988 in Hermeskeil, studied literary writing in Hildesheim and, in addition to writing, worked for many years in youth education. Her debut novel *Nachts ist es leise in Teheran* was published by Kiepenheuer&Witsch in 2016 and was awarded the Blogger Prize for Literature, the Ulla Hahn Authors' Prize, and the Uwe Johnson Sponsorship Prize, among others, and translated into several languages. *Drei Kameradinnen* followed in 2021 and was on the longlist for the German Book Prize.

Senthuran Varatharajah, born in 1984 in Jaffna/Sri Lanka, is a writer, philosopher and theologian. In 2016, his first novel *Vor der Zunahme der Zeichen* was published by S. Fischer Verlag. His second novel *Rot (Hunger)* was published in 2022, also by S. Fischer. Varatharajah's work has received many awards, including the Adalbert Chamisso Förderpreis, the Bremer Literaturförderpreis, the Kranichsteiner Literaturförderpreis, the Rauriser Literaturpreis, and the Villa Aurora Residency Fellowship in Los Angeles. Varatharajah lives in Berlin.

Anja Zag Golob (1976) is a Slovene poet, translator and columnist for the national radio. For 12 years she worked as a theatre critic. She is co-founder of the independent publishing house *VigeVageKnjige*, where she now works as editor-in-chief. So far, she

has published 4 poetry collections and received 3 prizes, twice for the best poetry collection of the past 2 years (The Jenko Prize - 2014, 2016), and once for the best book of the year (The Kritiško sito Prize - 2020). Her books have been translated into German, Polish, Serbian and Croatian, and her poetry has also been translated into 9 other languages. She is regularly invited to festivals at home and abroad as well as included in anthologies.
