An international competition awards the best poetry films. A focus will be dedicated to poetry filmmaking from Italy. "Prism" gives insights in the diversity of the current poetry film scene and a master class with Milena Tipaldo deals with the connection between poetry and animation. Moreover, there will be two readings with Italian poets at Haus für Poesie.
